
A Prayer for those Searching for the Truth

Sermon Notes: "Walking in the Way" (1 Kings 13.11-34)

Prayer Concerns

Boise Presbyterian Church: Pray for Rev. Brian Frey, our church planter in downtown Boise, that God strengthens and directs him each day as he labors to establish this young congregation.

God's Right Hand: David prays, "Though I walk in the midst of trouble, you preserve my life; you stretch out your hand against the wrath of my enemies, and your right hand delivers me" (Ps 138.7). In addition to strength and healing, pray that Eric Carpenter, Sandy Cupolillo, Roberta Haer, Judie Jud, Del Klicker, Tom Manning, Elizabeth Miller, Vickie Myers, and Samantha Schroeder might know the Lord's preserving and delivering hand this week.

The Persecuted Church: There are 173,000 Christians out of 83 million people in *Turkey*, a country whose main religion, Islam, is enmeshed with fanatical nationalism. Following an attempted coup in 2016, Turkey remains in a tense situation. Fierce rhetoric from the government has left little room for other voices, including the Christian church. The general opinion is that a true Turk is a Muslim. Pressured to return to Islam, Christian converts experience persecution from family, friends and community. Pray for believers who face bias against their faith, that they would not give up meeting together and studying the Word. Pray that they will find ways to share Christ with their friends and family. And pray that pastors are filled with wisdom and boldness as they minister to their congregations and look for opportunities to plant churches.

Tom & Melissa Manning (Turkey) continue to reach out to those who contacted them through the Saturation Outreach this past fall. Pray the Lord goes before them in each conversation, preparing hearts and granting faith to many. Pray as well that Tom and Melissa's residence visa will be renewed, and that Tom continues to feel well and that his cancer remains in remission.

Explanation of the Cover Symbol

In the Greek language of the early Christian era abbreviations were typically the first and last letters of words, often with a superscription to indicate the missing letters. IC is a standard abbreviation of IHCOYC, the Greek "Jesus," XC the abbreviation of XPICTOC, "Christ"; and NIKA means "He conquers." The symbol then reads, "Jesus Christ Conquers by the Cross" or "Jesus Christ, Victor."
