

The Lord's Supper

We celebrate the Lord's Supper by coming forward (generally from the back of the sanctuary to the front, though you may commune at any time) and partaking of the bread and the cup. Wine is served in the inner ring of each tray; grape juice in the outer ring. We warmly invite to the Table all baptized Christians, who are living under the authority of Christ and his body, the Church. By eating the bread and drinking of the cup, you are acknowledging that you are a sinner, without hope except in the sovereign mercy of God, and that you are trusting in Christ alone for salvation. If this does not describe you, we are glad you are here and commend to you the following prayers for your use during this time.

A Prayer for those Searching for the Truth

Jesus, you claim to be the way, the truth, and the life. Grant that I might be undaunted by the cost of following you as I consider the reasons for doing so. Guide me, teach me, and open to me the reality of who you are. Give me an understanding of you that is coherent, convincing, and leads to the life you promise. Amen.

A Prayer of Belief

Lord Jesus, I admit that I am weaker and more sinful than I ever believed, but through you I am more loved and accepted than I ever dared hope. I thank you for paying my debt, bearing my punishment on the cross, and offering forgiveness and new life. I turn from my sins and receive you as Savior and Lord. Amen.

A Prayer for those Struggling with Sin

Lord Jesus, grant that I may see in you the fulfillment of all my need and may turn from every false pleasure to feed on you, the true and living bread. Enable me to lay aside the sin that clings so closely, and run with perseverance the race set before me, looking to you, the author and perfecter of my faith. Amen.

Gatherings

Prayer Concerns

Boise Presbyterian Church: Pray for Rev. Brian Frey, our church planter in Boise, that God strengthen and directs him as he labors to establish this young congregation.

Rev. Chris & Mary Granberry (White Swan): Pray for the Granberrys and the Sacred Road team as they minister to the Yakama people, that God used them to convey the love of Christ to many, and that through their witness a great number on the reservation come to know and grow in the Savior.

The Persecuted Church: There are 180,000 Christians out of 10 million people in Jordan. Though they experience a measure of religious freedom, discrimination in employment and restrictions against free speech still exist. As a result, testimonies of faith by Christian converts can lead to physical violence, arrest, and even death. Add to that, radical Islamic movements, and the threats Christians feel are very real. Pray for those living under such oppression, that they follow Jesus' example as they respond. Pray for protection against radical Islamic groups. And pray for wisdom and courage to be faithful disciples of Christ, come what may.

The Steadfast Love of the LORD: The psalmist prayed, "I know, O LORD, that your rules are righteous, and that in faithfulness you have afflicted me. Let your steadfast love comfort me according to your promise to your servant. Let your mercy come to me, that I may live; for your law is my delight" (Ps 119.75-77). In addition to strength and healing, pray that Sandy Cupolillo, Mike Givens, Nancy Hoeft, Judie Jud, Tom Manning, Rick & Vickie Myers, Rich Parker, and Wayne Snavely are comforted this week by God's steadfast love.

Ukraine: Pray for the people of Ukraine, that God protects and preserves their freedom amidst the threat of Russian incursion, and for the church in Ukraine, that God strengthens and equips it to bear witness to the goodness of God and to the gospel during this very uncertain time.

The Shield of the Holy Trinity is frequently found in stained glass windows of medieval churches. This emblem expresses the Christian doctrine of the triunity of Almighty God, a truth taught in Scripture and affirmed by the Council of Constantinople in AD 381.
