The Lord's Supper

We celebrate the Lord's Supper by coming forward (generally from the back of the sanctuary to the front) and partaking of the bread and the cup. Wine is served in the inner ring of each tray, grape juice in the outer rings. We warmly invite to the Table all baptized Christians, who are living under the authority of Christ and his body, the Church. By eating the bread and drinking of the cup, you are acknowledging that you are a sinner, without hope except in the sovereign mercy of God, and that you are trusting in Christ alone for salvation. If this does not describe you, we are glad you are here and commend the following prayer for your use during this time.

Jesus, you claim to be the way, the truth, and the life. Grant that I might be undaunted by the cost of following you as I consider the reasons for doing so. Prayer Concerns

Saint Andrews Presbyterian Church: Rev. Craig Harris is planting a church in Yakima. Pray for God's blessing as he gives himself to this work, and that the Lord leads him to many who are hungry to hear and respond to the gospel.

The Giver of Strength & Peace: David prayed, "The LORD gives strength to his people; the LORD blesses his people with peace" (Ps 29.11). In addition to strength and healing, pray that Paul Carmichael, Sandy Cupolillo, Mike Givens, Nancy Hoeft, Judie Jud, Tom Manning, and Rick & Vickie Myers are filled with the LORD'S strength and peace in the week ahead.

Chris & Mary Granberry (White Swan): Pray for the Granberrys and the Sacred Road team as they minister to the Yakama people, that God uses them to convey the love of Christ to many, and that through their witness a great number on the reservation come to know the Savior and grow in him.

The Persecuted Church: There are 350,000 Christians out of 33 million people in *Uzbekistan*, where all unsanctioned religious expression is outlawed. This means any non-Orthodox Christian group is illegal, and since the culture is largely Muslim, those who do convert to Christianity face pressure and threat of violence from their families and communities. Pray for the safety of such converts. Pray for those who are isolated from other believers because of fear of being found out; pray that they will find fellowship and peace. And pray for the growth and health of the church in Uzbekistan.

Explanation of the Cover Symbol

The Shield of the Holy Trinity is frequently found in stained glass windows of medieval churches. This emblem expresses the Christian doctrine of the triunity of Almighty God, a truth taught in Scripture and affirmed by the Council of Constantinople in AD 381.
